## What is its purpose:

The Big Button Telephone is the perfect device for those struggling to use their existing landline phone with ease.

## What do I need to be able to use it:

The phone is plugged in to a standard telephone wall socket and is corded.

## Where can I get one?:

Either through NRS online or you can visit a Clearwell Mobility shop. Other online shops may also supply this product.

## How much does it cost?:

The cheaper basic models range from £30 - £50.
